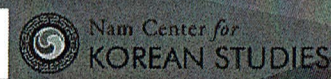

## **Fan Dance**

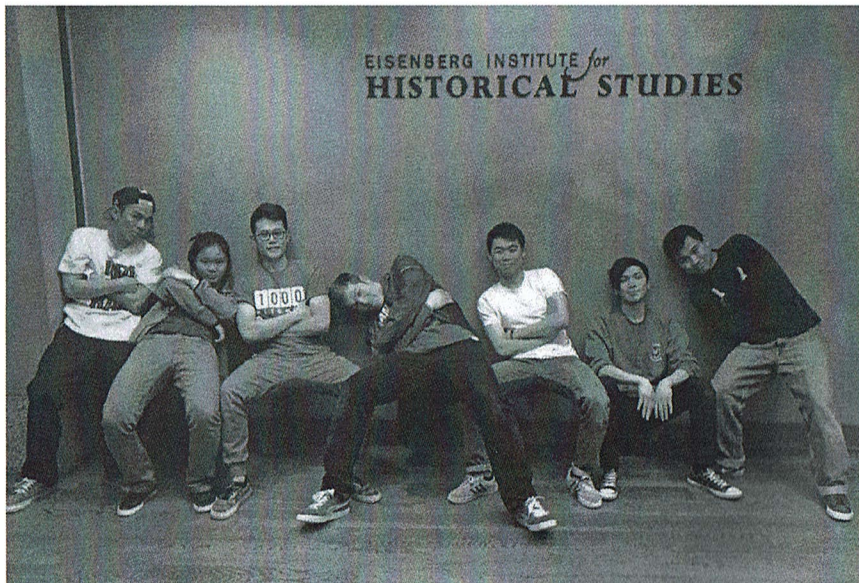

## Sinaboro

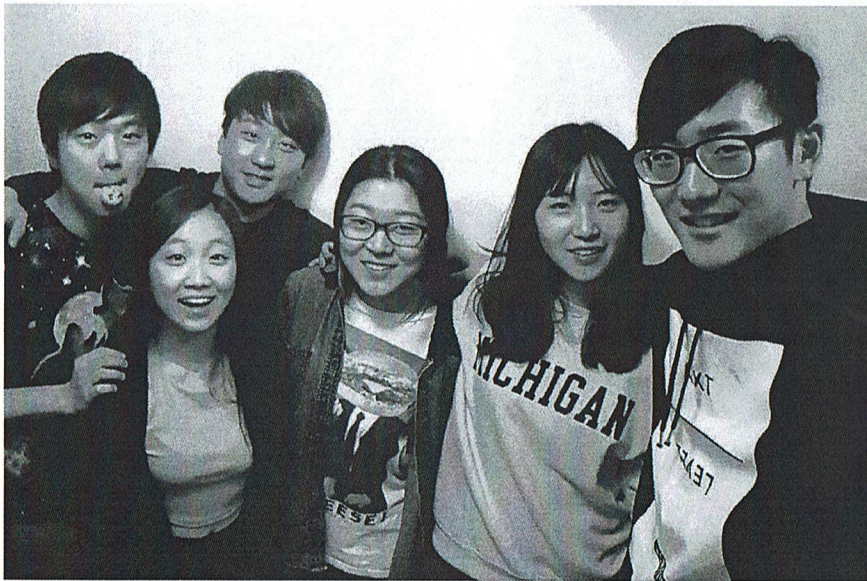
